
I am directed to inform you that Work Permit No. 1646/2004 valid for the period 2004 September 16 to 2007 September 15 has been granted to Mr. Pablo Giovanni Paez Monroy (Ecuadorean National) to be employed with TouchPoint Centers International (Ja.) Limited as Chief Operations Officer.

Mr. Paez Monroy is required to have a valid visa endorsed in his passport before entering the island. Thereafter, he should attend at the Immigration Office, 25 Constant Spring Road, Kingston 10 with this letter and his passport for endorsement and registration. He should then attend at this Ministry, 1F North Street, Kingston and on presentation of his endorsed passport and the Certificate issued by the Immigration Office, his permit will be delivered to him personally. It should be noted that if the permit is not collected within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter, it will be cancelled.

You are advised that the above permit is not transferable and that both employer and employee will be liable to prosecution in the event that there is a contravention in this regard.

Please note that on completion of his term of employment, the work permit card must be retrieved and returned to this Ministry.
